Portfolio Guideline (2022 Entry)

1. Applicants are required to present their portfolios during the interview.
2. They should prepare their portfolios in digital format for the ease of presentation.
3. The portfolios should demonstrate candidates' potential in creativity, storytelling techniques and the concepts of images.
4. If your portfolio is a video, please show us the best 2 minutes of your work. We prefer to watch an original 2-minute excerpt from ONE project, instead of a 2-minute showreel edited from different projects unless you have strong reasons (e.g. you mainly work as a cameraman and want to show us different style).
5. If your portfolio is a screenplay, film review or academic writing or other visual media, please arrange them in a file.
6. Applicants will use the function of “Sharing Your Screen” to present their portfolios during the online interview.
7. The demo reel shall not exceed **3 minutes**.
