

Bachelor of Communication -Film Major (Film and TV Concentration)(JS2330) Portfolio Guideline (2022 Entry)

- 1. Applicants are required to present their portfolios during the interview.
- 2. They should prepare their portfolios in digital format for the ease of presentation.
- 3. The portfolios should demonstrate candidates' potential in creativity, storytelling techniques and the concepts of images.
- 4. If your portfolio is a video, please show us the best 2 minutes of your work. We prefer to watch an original 2-minute excerpt from ONE project, instead of a 2-minute showreel edited from different projects unless you have strong reasons (e.g. you mainly work as a cameraman and want to show us different style).
- 5. If your portfolio is a screenplay, film review or academic writing or other visual media, please arrange them in a file.
- 6. Applicants will use the function of "Sharing Your Screen" to present their portfolios during the online interview.
- 7. The demo reel shall not exceed 3 minutes.
