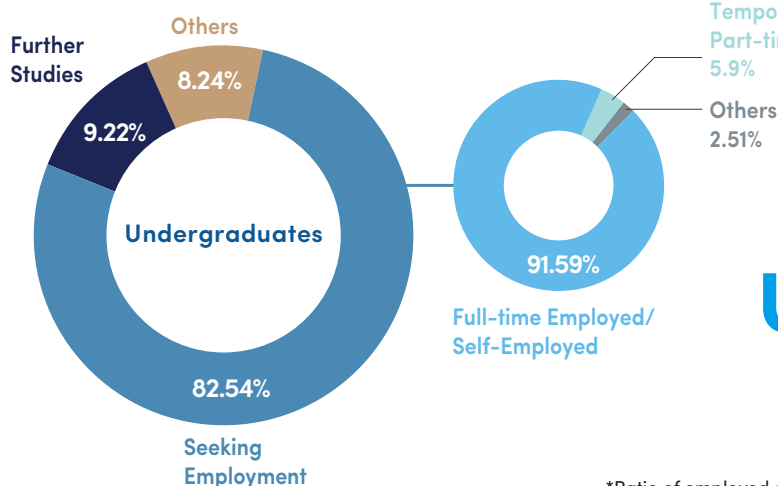

# ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

A wide range of qualifications are accepted, examples are provided below for reference.

## GENERAL ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

### American-patterned Education

High School Graduation Diploma with one of the following:

- **SAT**: Minimum score of 1,190 out of 1,600
- **AP**: Grade 3 in at least two AP subjects
- **ACT**: Minimum composite score of 23

### British-patterned Education

GCE Advanced Level (AL) / International Advanced Level (IAL)

- Grade E or above in three AL / IAL subjects; or
- Grade E or above in two AL / IAL subjects plus two ASL subjects (Not including Chinese and English Language subjects. The same subject cannot be counted at both AL and ASL.)

### Admission scholarships of up to USD124,000 for outstanding non-local students

- Full Scholarship (100% Tuition + subsidies)<sup>2&3</sup>

- Half Scholarship (50% of Full Scholarship)<sup>2&3</sup>
- Other Entrance Scholarship (25% Tuition or above)<sup>2</sup>
