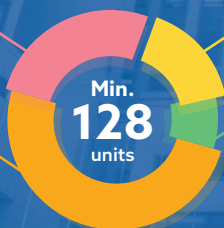

Transfer of Units

Senior year entrants will be recommended for transfer of units. In general, the number of transferable units will not exceed 50% of the total number of units required for graduation.

Summer Programme Opportunities

Senior year entrants are welcome to enrol in the Summer Programme which normally takes place in July in advance of the official commencement of studies in September.

 - Receive conditional or firm admission offer, if any

- 3 Offer Acceptance**
 - Settle admission confirmation fee

- 4 Summer Programme (for students admitted to Year 3)**
 - Enrolment is subject to the availability of course quota

- 5 Fulfilment of Offer Conditions**
 - Submit supporting documents

- 6 Orientation**
 - Complete new student registration and join orientation activities in mid-August 2026
 - Commence study in early September 2026
