

JS2021 BA (Hons) in Chinese Language and Literature

The Programme is committed to providing thorough training in research methods, problem-solving skills, and critical thinking skills in Chinese language, literature, and culture. It aims to enable students to achieve academic goals, build moral character, promote personal growth, and initiate a commitment to lifelong learning in preparation for their future careers.

JS2022 BA (Hons) in Creative and Professional Writing

The Programme is the first UGC-funded undergraduate programme among Hong Kong tertiary institutions dedicated to creative and professional writing in both Chinese and English.

JS2023 BA (Hons) in English Language and Literature

The Programme offers you the chance to develop disciplinary expertise in the English language and in literatures in English in multilingual and global contexts across time. You shall realize your professional ambitions through a training that is both intellectually vigorous and holistic in the spirit of whole-person education.

JS2024 BA (Hons) in Humanities

The Programme is the first undergraduate programme in Hong Kong dedicated to providing a broad liberal arts education. Apart from training students to think critically, write logically and speak confidently, the Humanities Programme also nurtures students' ability to solve problems, to sympathize with humanity and to appreciate life, qualities which are indeed essential for a successful career as well as a full meaningful life.

JS2025 BA (Hons) in Religion, Philosophy and Ethics

The Programme, specializing in three different but closely related disciplines of religion, philosophy and ethics, is the first-of-its-kind not only in Hong Kong, but also in Asia. We study the analysis of underlying moral values, social values and cultural values in current issues. Students will benefit from writing, public presentation and critical thinking skills, as well as close student-teacher relationships.

JS2026 BA (Hons) in Translation

The Programme is specifically designed to train bilingual and bicultural communicators to operate in local and national markets in the 21st century. Since the Programme started in 1990, our graduates have taken up a whole range of rewarding careers, and have been contributing to society by applying the knowledge and experience gained from the Programme.

JS2030 BA (Hons) in Music

The Programme provides graduates with a practical and intellectual foundation for careers in music or another music-related field. The course is designed to enable our graduates to work intelligently and creatively towards their own areas of special interest.

In Year II, students declare their specialties in one of the four Concentrations: Composition; Performance; Directed Studies; and Music Education.

Depending on their chosen Concentration, a selection of concentration courses in Years II & III prepares students for the Honours Project in Year IV, in the format of a composition portfolio, a concerto and recital performance, a lecture-recital, or a written thesis on music history, theory, music education, or another music-related topic.

JS2040 BA (Hons) in English Language and Literature and BEd (Hons) in English Language Teaching (Double Degree)

The Programme is a five-year full-time programme leading to two degree awards. It is offered jointly by the Department of English Language & Literature (ENG) and the Department of Education Studies (EDUC). It provides thorough preparation in two distinct disciplines: English Language & Literature and Education Studies. Students who successfully complete the Programme will hold a recognised teaching qualification that meets the Government's requirements for professional English language teachers.

JS2050 Bachelor of Music (Hons) in Creative Industries

The Programme provides comprehensive training to aspiring composers, vocalists, and instrumentalists for careers in the creative and entertainment industries, and plenty of opportunities to hone their skills in music technology, composition, performance, production, and entrepreneurship. It offers a new career pathway for students with two concentrations: Popular Music Performance and Songwriting, and Scoring for Film, Television and Video Games.
