For an award-winning film: 1) The complete award-winning film. 2) A continuous 5-minute excerpt from the award-winning film. b. For an award-winning screenplay / story which is not produced into a film yet: 1) The complete awardwinning screenplay / story 2) Summary of the screenplay / story (no more than 300 words)	`q
