課程簡介

何謂國家？何謂公民？何謂全球化？民主與民粹的分別又是甚麼？為什麼世界上有不同的政治體制？為什麼人類會參與政治生活？變化萬千和衝突不斷的世界又將往何處去？政治及國際關係社會科學學士(榮譽)學位課程正是為解釋以上的問題而設立。課程為同學提供研習政治科學的扎實基礎，學習範圍包括比較政治、國際關係、公共政策、公共行政、政治哲學、政治經濟學、政治理論、統計學和研究方法等。

在四年制學士本科課程下，香港浸會大學文學及社會科學院為六個主修學科進行聯合招生，包括：

- 歐洲研究
- 地理
- 全球及中國研究
- 政治及國際關係學
- 社會學
- 歷史

在完成首學年的社會科學基礎教育課程後，同學可按其興趣和成績申請政治及國際關係學為主修學科，修讀政治及國際關係學社會科學學士(榮譽)學位課程。

課程目的

政治科學是文學及社會科學中重要環節。學科旨在分析和研究政治體制、政治行為、政府、國際關係和其他與政治相關議題。課程的目的是培育具備全球視野、分析能力、嚴謹思考、研究觸覺和社會關懷的人才。

課程特色

- 學系成員來自世界上十多個國家，亦不時邀請其他訪問學者到訪，師資國際化。
- 學系與名校 Sciences Po Bordeaux 和 Sciences Po Lyon 恆常合作，舉辦聯合課程。經常舉辦學術研討活動，邀請同學參與。經常與領事館及公營機構、非政府機構和商業機構合作，舉辦活動和講座。積極安排實習和海外交流活動，擴闊同學視野。學系特別受國際留學生歡迎，提供機會讓同學與不同國籍和文化的的朋友交流。

Programme Description

What is globalisation? What makes a state? Who are citizens? What are the differences between democracy and populism? Why are there so many different political systems in the world? Which ones are working and which are not? Where is our rapidly changing and contentious world heading to? BSocSc (Hons) in Government & International Studies programme seeks to answer these questions. It aims to give students rigorous training in different areas of political science, covering comparative politics, government and public policy-making, international relations, political economy, political theory, political philosophy and research methodology.

Under the **four-year undergraduate degree programme**, the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences of Hong Kong Baptist University offers broad-based admission for **six Majors**:

- **European Studies**
- **Geography**
- **Global & China Studies**
- **Government & International Studies**
- **Sociology**
- **History**

In their **first year**, students receive broad social sciences training without having any specific majors.

After **completing their first year of study**, students may apply for Government & International Studies as their Major and enrol into the Bachelor of Social Sciences (Hons) in Government & International Studies programme subject to their academic performances.

Programme Mission

Political science is a crucial component in the arts and social sciences. It explores political institutions, political behavior, international relations and other pertinent areas. The programme aims to nurture students into individuals with analytical abilities, critical thinking, research potential, a global vision and care for society.
