

### C. Internship-Local Placement (2 units) and Internship-Overseas Placement (2 units)

Students can acquire practical work experience by fulfilling 250 hours of local internship in agencies such as National Sport Organizations, Leisure and Cultural Services Department and 250 hours of overseas internship in agencies such as Walt Disney World, Recreation and Sports Camp in USA, Australia and Taiwan etc.



### D. Honours Project (6 units)

Students are required to initiate, conduct and write up a research project in the final year of studies by integrating professional knowledge and research skills into the project.
