Portfolio Submission Guidelines for JEE applicants

(for Academic year 2024/25)

Selected JEE applicants would be invited for an interview in the end of June 2024. The selected candidate is expected to present a portfolio during the interview.

The portfolio is a selection of the applicant's recent creative works (if possible from within the past three years) that reflect their strengths in creative practice. The selection the applicant makes for the portfolio should emphasise their individual ideas and interests and should show that they are enthusiastic and ambitious to enter a career relating to arts and technology.

Portfolio Requirements

Every applicant is requested to present a portfolio of **three** works:

The creative works can be:

- Traditional art forms: such as drawing, painting, sculpture, installation, film and video, photography, performance and musical composition;
- Digital arts and design: such as interactive and immersive art, apps and website design, VR, AR, and gaming developments, etc.
- STEAM (science, technology, engineering, the arts, and maths) projects: such as creative experiments with electronics, robotics and model building.
